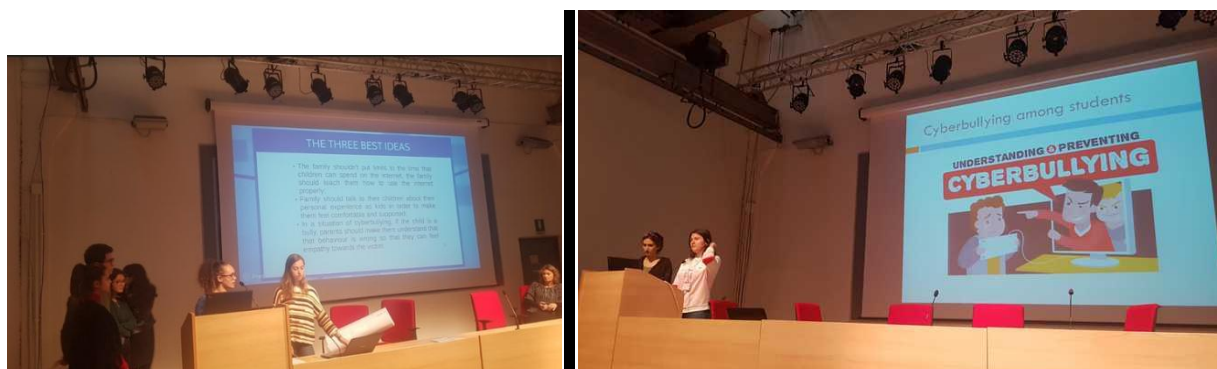

## E- SAFETY PRACTISES BETWEEN THE YEARS 2018 - 2020

- We got **SELFIE SCHOOL** label in 2019.
  - The Joint Research Centre of the European Commission has launched a **SELFIE** tool to support digital teaching and learning through the use of digital technologies in EU schools and provide guidance on digital capabilities of schools. In April 2019, we were informed that we had been chosen as a pilot school with 212 other schools that showed an evidence to their cyber studies and we got our **SELFIE SCHOOL** label in May, 2019. - We got **e - safety** label in 2019.
  - In December 2019, we got our e safety label with a total score of 47.7 indicating a silver label. We have embedded the label to our schools website.

- We provided e-Safety support with a ka229 project for pupils outside curriculum time.
  - We conducted a KA2 Erasmus+ school partnership project with three different European partners in last 2 years called "European Step to Stop Cyber bullying". Our school was the coordinator of the project. Also the students published a joint declaration with their European peers. You may find the document in user guidance section. Another activity was conducting an e-twinning project with the same name and getting a quality label from Portuguese national support service with this Project.
- **Our Students contributed writing GUIDELINES AGAINST CYBERBULLYING / SUGGESTIONS FOR SCHOOLS, IN THE MEETING OF PONTEDERA (ITALY) - 21/27 OCTOBER 2018**

In multinational groups, 18 students of Eskişehir Anadolu Lisesi contributes writing guidelines against cyber bullying. With their other European peers, they wrote their suggestion offers to local authorities, parents and schools. They presented their ideas to Pontedera's local educational directorates. When they came back to Turkey, they shared their suggestions with local directorate of education of Eskişehir.





- **We got a policy about Pupil and staff access to technology.**
  - We have lockers in each class so students are expected to put their phones in the lockers and sometimes, regarding the aims and necessities of the lesson they may use their phones by taking permission from their teachers.
  - The details of pupils' personal data are never sent publicly in school's website. For example, a few letters of pupils names and surnames are excluded in school news, their identity numbers are never sent.
  - The policy is explicitly announced in school's website.

- **We provided e-Safety support for parents.**

- Our students elaborated Cyber bullying in small groups with the guidance of our English Language teacher.

The students investigated many aspects of cyberbullying and present them to their peers to equip them fully about the topic. With these small talks in their mother tongue, we tried to raise the awareness of the students.



- Our teachers trained on the topic of cyber bullying.
  - Last year we provided information to each and every teacher about cyber safety. - **We organized a seminar cooperating with a university club.**
  - In December 2019, we organized cooperating with SODİGEM - a club whose main aim is to raise the awareness of young people about cyber safety, internet etiquette, laws, and punishments about cyber issues. In this seminar the students and experts from Anadolu University talked to our students about cyber safety, law sanctions about cyber crimes and perceptions in social media. - **We organized an e safety and etwinning seminar to 15 teachers coming from England, Portugal, Greece and Romania.**

Within the activities of our strategic school partnership project, our English language teacher provided a seminar about e twinning and e safety rules to 15 teachers coming from England, Portugal, Greece and Romania.
